Reykjavík City Card

This card includes all public transportation and admission to a variety of museums as well as all of the city's swimming pools. A 24-hour city card will cost you ISK 3,700 per person.



Hop-on/Hop-off Bus with Reykjavík Excursions

Hop on a double-decker bus that takes you to Reykjavík's most iconic sites in just one hour. The tour costs ISK 4,000 per person.



Tales of Iceland Exhibition

Within walking distance of the hotel you'll find an interactive exhibition where you can learn about the history of Iceland. For example, you can read newspapers from every decade to learn about the most critical events in Iceland's history.



City Walking Tour with Reykjavík Sightseeing

Take an expertly guided walking tour around the city with Reykjavík Sightseeing. The 2.5-hour tour departs from Hallgrímskirkja church at 14:00 and ends with refreshments at Bryggjan Brugghús restaurant and brewery by the harbor. Price per person is ISK 6,990.



Whale Watching & Whales of Iceland Exhibition

Join the Special Tours whale experience at 13:00. Whale watching is one of the most popular activities in the city and the Whales of Iceland Exhibition is the biggest whale exhibition in the world. Price per person is ISK 13,600.

The Volcano House

Learn about the geology of Iceland at the Volcano House. The museum features an exhibition about Icelandic volcanos, including a theater where you can sit down and watch documentaries about some of the most famous eruptions of Iceland's history. Price per person for the Documentary Show is ISK 1,590.
